<sup>6</sup> Performing Arts courses must be taken from two disciplines, three credits from each (either CMS and PEA, CMS and MUS, or PEA and MUS). Courses for this option include CMS 75, Acting I, (3cr.); and PEA 41, Techniques in Jazz, (1cr.); PEA 46, African, Caribbean and Black Dance Forms, (2 cr.); and PEA 47, Beginning Salsa, (1 cr.). Students who want to take 3 courses (4 cr.) of Dance, may use one of these credits toward the Free Elective or Physical Education requirement. Other courses in the Option are MUS 21, 22 and 23. Only one MUS course can be taken per semester. Students start with MUS 21, Choral Performance, (1 cr.) and take MUS 22, Choral Performance (1cr.) and MUS 23, Choral Performance (1cr.)
