B. Admission Requirements for Senior College Program

About the Program

This human services degree offers comprehensive preparation for people-centered work in public, private, and not-for-profit organizations. A broad range of academic studies, including philosophy, history, psychology, economics, political science, sociology, management, and communications, are integrated with professional skills and mentored workplace experience.

Admissions

Metropolitan College of New York Bachelor of Professional Studies in Human Services requires completion of 120 credits with a 2.0 cumulative grade point average. A minimum GPA of 2.0 from BCC is required for admission under this articulation agreement. It allows qualified graduates of Bronx Community College to receive the equivalent of four (4) semesters of transfer credit at MCNY toward the BPS degree. Students with an earned BCC Associate in Applied Sciences meeting the above criteria will be eligible to enter directly into their fifth semester at MCNY. An additional 60 credits are required to earn the MCNY BPS degree which can be completed in a minimum of one year and four months as full time students. Students are eligible to initially enroll with MCNY for any one of the three semesters (Spring, Summer, or Fall). All applicants to MCNY must complete all required admission documents as set forth by the Admission Office from time to time.

Associate in Arts Degree from Bronx Community College.

Bronx Community College graduates with the Associate in Applied Sciences Degree in Human Services will receive 60 credits toward the Bachelor of Professional Studies in Human Services at Metropolitan College of New York.

2. Procedures for evaluating agreement, e.g., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:


After transfer into the MCNY major, the performance of Bronx Community College students will be tracked. MCNY will inform BCC about the academic progress of transfer students




