Students may select either a 4-credit STEM variant science course or a 3-credit science course to fuffill Required Core C. Students selecting a 3 -credit course must also complete an additional 1 -credit lab course to fulfill graduation requirements.
It is recommended that students planning to transfer to City College take COMM 20.
It is recommended that students take a second course in the same language if they have lective credits.
The Modern Language Department will consider exemption requests for students who present appropriate evidence that they have completed full-time study at a college or university outside of the United States in which the language of instruction was other than English. These students will be exempted from a foreign language requirement at Bronx Community College. It is recommended that students planning to transfer to Lehman College's Early Childhood/ Childhood Education Program take EDU 26.
NYS Education Department requires teacher education candidates to complete a three credit course designed to meet the needs of all students in an inclusive classroom (EDU 30). After May 2014, teacher candidates will be required to take an examination-Educating All Students.
Students planning to transfer to Lehman College must achieve a 3.0 index in their Education coursework at BCC and a grade point average of 2.75 or better for admission into Lehman College's Early Childhood/Childhood Program.
