The curriculum has obtained a waiver to require its students to take BIO 11 and CHM 17 or the sequence BIO 23/BIO 24 in the Common Core. If students transferring into this program complete different courses in these areas, they will be certified as having completed the Common Core requirements, but it may not be possible for them to finish their degree within the regular number (60) of credits.

²Select any physical education course except PEA 12 and PEA 82.

³Students who are not planning on transferring to a 4-year program in Community Health are encouraged to take this course.

⁴Select from any Modern Language listed above at appropriate level. Students who have passed two years of a Modern Language in high school are exempt from this requirement and may take additional free elective credits.
