Students selecting a 3-credit course in this area will have to take a 4-credit STEM variant science course in Flexible Area E in order to fulfill the lab requirement.

³Select from any ENG course above ENG 16 with the exception of ENG 223.

⁴Select from any Modern Language listed at appropriate level with the exception of ITL 123. Students who enter with successful completion of two years of a foreign language in high school have fulfilled their college language requirement. These students will take additional language coursework or choose other free elective credits.

⁵It is recommended that students use free elective credits to take MEDP 18. Select additional free electives in consultation with Media Studies advisor.
