A student who places out of SPN 111, 112 and 113 will begin the Spanish Specialization sequence with SPN 20 and complete four courses. In some cases, SPN 124 or SPN 125 may substitute for SPN 130/131. No credit will be granted toward the Spanish Option for a course taken under a student's proficiency level.
