²Students with prior MTH 5 placement (or Math Proficiency Index of 40 to 59) may now take MTH 20. Passing MTH 20 is equivalent to MTH 23.

³Students who take or transfer with MTH 30 or MTH 31 will have fulfilled Required Core B & will reduce free elective credits by one.

⁴Students may select either a 4-credit STEM variant science course or a 3-credit science course to fulfill Required Core C. Students selecting a 3-credit course must also complete an additional 1-credit lab course to fulfill graduation requirements.
