These students will be exempted from a foreign language requirement at Bronx Community College. ⁸It is recommended that students planning to transfer to Lehman College's Early Childhood/ Childhood Education Program take EDU 26.

⁹NYS Education Department requires teacher education candidates to complete a three credit course designed to meet the needs of all students in an inclusive classroom (EDU 30). After May 2014, teacher candidates will be required to take an examination-Educating All Students.

Students planning to transfer to Lehman College must achieve a 3.0 index in their Education coursework at BCC and a grade point average of 2.75 or better for admission into Lehman College's Early Childhood/Childhood Program.
