${ }^{2}$ Students with prior MTH 5 placement (or Math Proficiency Index of 40 to 59) may now take MTH 20. Passing MTH 20 is equivalent to MTH 23 .
${ }^{3}$ Students may select either a 4 -credit STEM variant science course or a 3 -credit science course to fulfill Required Core C. Students selecting a 3-credit course must also complete an additional 1 -credit lab course to fulfill graduation requirements.
