<sup>1</sup>Students with prior ENG 1/RDL 1 placements (or English Proficiency Index < 50) will now take ENG 4 or RDL 4. Passing ENG 4 or RDL 4 will allow them to register for ENG 110.

<sup>2</sup>Students with prior MTH 5 placement (or Math Proficiency Index of 40 to 59) may now take MTH 20. Passing MTH 20 is equivalent to MTH 23.

<sup>3</sup>Students may select either a 4-credit STEM variant science course or a 3-credit science course to fulfill Required Core C. Students selecting a 3-credit course must also complete an additional 1-credit lab course to fulfill graduation requirements.

<sup>7</sup>HIS 31 Modern Latin American History and HIS 39 History of the Caribbean are recommended electives.

<sup>8</sup>Students must take the Spanish Placement exam prior to enrolling in their first Spanish course. Placement scores will determine the first sequence of Spanish courses. See Modern Language Department to schedule the placement exam.
