<sup>2</sup>Students with prior MTH 5 placement (or Math Proficiency Index of 40 to 59) may now take MTH 20. Passing MTH 20 is equivalent to MTH 23.

<sup>3</sup>Students must take FYS 11 prior to earning 24 degree or equated credits. Students who have earned 24 or more degree or equated credits are permitted to use the one credit as a free elective. It is highly recommended that students take FYS 11 in their first or second semester. This requirement will be waived for students who have earned 24 or more degree or equated credits at BCC or another college and transfer into this program.

<sup>4</sup>Reserved for students who have English remedial need and enroll in ENG 2, RDL 2, or ENG 110 as a corequisite.

<sup>5</sup>Students must choose one science course. This course may be selected from any 3-credit courses included in Required Core C or Flexible Core E. Completion of a 4-credit science course will fulfill this requirement, but is not mandatory. This may result in students exceeding 60 total degree credits.

<sup>6</sup>Students transferring into the program with 24 or more degree or equated credits will be exempt from FYS 11 and only required to complete 60 credits to graduate.
