

Kalief Browder Memorial Scholarship – Fall/Spring 2021-2022

Scholarship Criteria

Applicants must be Bronx Community College (BCC) students who:

- 1. Were formerly justice-involved or have a parent/ guardian or relative that was/is impacted by the justice system;
- 2. Are currently enrolled in a matriculated program and are on track to complete their degree. Preference given to full-time students;
- 3. Are in good academic standing: full-time students have completed a minimum of 12 credits/equated hours and part-time applicants must be on track to graduate the academic year of the award;
- 4. Have a minimum of 2 remaining semesters at BCC (this may include the semester of award);
- 5. Have a demonstrated financial need;
- 6. Have completed and submitted the application below including essay (required);
- 7. Preference may given to students who are also currently/formerly in foster care, though not a requirement.

- b) Two recipients will be selected to receive \$2,500 tuition scholarships for the 2021-2022 academic year;
- c) Recipient may be asked to participate in BCC Foundation events or interviews, however, this is not a requirement for securing the scholarship.

***If you are selected to receive a BCC Foundation Scholarship, you will be required to
submit: a photo and a "Thank You" letter, which will be shared with the scholarship's
donors. You may be invited to attend special events and/or meetings. The funds will be
deposited to your CUNYfirst account once the thank you letter is received. ***
