¹ENG 100/110/111 plus one course from ENG 112, 114, 115, and 116. It is recommended that students choose ENG 115.

²ENG 1/ENG 2 & RDL 1/RDL 2 are no longer available. Students with ENG/RDL remedial needs will now enroll in corequisite course ENG 100 (If English Proficiency Index < 50), or ENG 110 (If English Proficiency Index = 50-64).

³MTH 1/MTH 5 are no longer available. Students with Math Proficiency Index of 59 or lower may now enroll in corequisite courses MTH 21.5 or MTH 23.5. Students with 39 or lower MPI are strongly encouraged to enroll in Math Start/CUNY Start.

⁴Students may select either a 3-credit science course plus a lab course (1 cr.) or 4-credit STEM variant science course to fulfill Required Core C. Students selecting a 3-credit course in this area will have to take a 4-credit STEM variant science course in Flexible Area E in order to fulfill the lab requirement.

⁶Reserved for students who have English remedial need, and enroll in ENG 2, RDL 2, or ENG 110 as a corequisite.

The Modern Language Department will consider exemption requests for students who present appropriate evidence that they have completed full-time study at a college or university outside of the United States in which the language of instruction was other than English. These students will be exempted from a foreign language requirement at Bronx Community College.

⁸Select additional free electives in consultation with Performing Arts advisor.
