²MTH 1/MTH 5 are no longer available. Students with Math Proficiency Index of 59 or lower may now enroll in corequisite courses MTH 21.5 or MTH 23.5. Students with 39 or lower MPI are strongly encouraged to enroll in Math Start/CUNY Start.

⁴CHM 11 or PHY 11 is strongly recommended in Flexible Core E.

These students will be exempted from a foreign language requirement at Bronx Community College.

⁹It is recommended that students take PSY 11 in this area.

¹⁰This requirement is satisfied if a student takes a 4-credit STEM variant course in Required Area C.
