

## Kalief Browder Memorial Scholarship

**YOU** may be eligible for a one-year, **\$2,500 scholarship** 

## Applicants must be Bronx Community College (BCC) students who:

- 1. Were formerly justice-involved or have a parent/ guardian or relative that was/ is impacted by the justice system;
- 2. Are currently enrolled in a matriculated program and are on track to complete their degree. Preference given to full-time students;
- 3. Are in good academic standing full-time students have completed a minimum of 12 credits/equated hours and part-time applicants must be on track to graduate the academic year of the award;
- 4. Have a minimum of 2 remaining semesters at BCC (this may include the semester of award);
- 5. Have a demonstrated financial need;
- 6. Have completed and submitted the application including essay (required);
- 7. Preference may be given to students who are also currently/formerly in foster care, though not a requirement.

**Complete an essay** on "Describe how and why Kalief Browder's story resonates with you. How would receiving his scholarship help you advance your academic and professional goals?"
