Memorial Scholarship

YOU may be eligible for a one-year, **\$2,500 scholarship**

Applicants must be Bronx Community College (BCC) students who:

1. Were formerly justice-involved or have a parent/ guardian or relative that was/ is impacted by the justice system;
2. Are currently enrolled in a matriculated program and are on track to complete their degree. Preference given to full-time students;
3. Are in good academic standing – full-time students have completed a minimum of 12 credits/equated hours and part-time applicants must be on track to graduate the academic year of the award;
4. Have a minimum of 2 remaining semesters at BCC (this may include the semester of award);
5. Have a demonstrated financial need;
6. Have completed and submitted the application including essay (required);
7. Preference may be given to students who are also currently/formerly in foster care, though not a requirement.

Complete an essay on “Describe how and why Kalief Browder’s story resonates with you. How would receiving his scholarship help you advance your academic and professional goals?”
