The attached updated COVID Guidelines for Fall 2022 provide guidance for vaccinations, masking, quarantine and isolation, visitors and shutdown procedures. These guidelines include minor updates from Spring 2022. Campus reopening plans must be updated and reflect these university standards.

Please find below the items that all CUNY Schools MUST include in their Plans. Fall 2022 plans <u>do not</u> need to be resubmitted to CUNY for further review but must be attested to below.

- All Fall 2022 campus plans must include the following items from the Reopening Guidance
  - Students who are new and/or returning to campus in the fall are **required** to be vaccinated. Student participation in on-campus activities will require proof of vaccination. Only medical or religious exemptions will be accepted.
    - Booster shots should be strongly encouraged.
  - Face Masks will not be required at this time. Individuals can choose to continue wearing masks, and campuses must ensure masks remain available.
  - CUNY will continue to require that individuals comply with <u>CDC Guidelines for Isolation and Quarantine</u>. Protocols
    must be in place to care for any on-campus residents required to isolate or quarantine.
  - In compliance with the CUNY <u>Visitor's Policy</u>, every visitor to a CUNY campus, whether accessing indoor or outdoor spaces, must provide proof to CUNY that they (i) are fully vaccinated or (ii) have had a negative COVID-19 molecular (PCR) test performed by an accredited lab no more than 7 days prior to the visit.
  - CUNY will continue its robust testing program using various testing models for the safety and convenience of the CUNY community.
    - All students are expected to test before returning to campus.
    - Student athletes and students in residence halls will be required to submit a negative PCR test before returning to campus.
    - Weekly testing will continue for those who are unvaccinated and expand to cover students in residence halls, regardless of vaccination status.
    - Overall random testing of 20% of the on-campus population. Participation in the random surveillance testing is mandatory and failure to participate will result in the removal of the individual's Cleared4 access pass to CUNY spaces.
  - Continue to aid in the identification of exposures, and notify close contacts, as appropriate, of exposure as soon as possible after being notified that someone in the campus has tested positive or been diagnosed with COVID-19.
  - Maintain a plan for shut down in accordance with the <u>Reclosing Protocols: CUNY's Guide for Safely Closing On-</u> <u>Campus Operations</u>.
