Minutes of February 8, 2023 (Loew Hall, 200)

- 1. **Call to Order:** At 2:04 P.M., meeting called to order by S. Powers.
- 2. **Approval of the November 9, 2022, minutes**: After a motion by A. Rivers, the minutes from 11/9/22 were approved as amended unanimously by the 14 voting members present. *N. Cano and K. Ismail. arrived after the vote*.
- 3. **Announcements:** S. Powers reported that the certificate residency proposal was accepted by the Senate as was the RAD proposal.
- 4. **Appeals report:** A. Rose-Glenn updated on the appeals that occurred in January. Processed 247 academic appeals since end of December. On behalf of C. Byrd, she thanked those who assisted with advising and appeals. S. Powers also thanked those members who helped with appeals.
- 5. Appeals section of the codification: (see agenda) S. Powers noted that, due to recent changes with appeals, the codification language needs to be reviewed. He led members through the possibly problematic areas including the Pass/No Pass policy, the F-replacement policy, WA policy, WU policy, R grade policy, grade appeals (section 8.8), FYFFP, and waiver of dismissal. Discussion ensued. A. Rivers explained how when students register for a class in a subsequent semester prior to completing it (when they know they will have an F in the current semester), to allow the registration, it's inputted in the system as a repeat, which is what can trip up the F-replacement leading to incorrect replacement of subsequent grades lower than a C replacing that prior F. A. Ott reported the Bronx Transfer Affinity group has a proposal into CUNY regarding the cap on F-replacement credits as well the C grade requirement. S. Powers noted there have been more requests from students appealing academic grades and reminded members of the procedure for those appeals, which are handled by the department holding the class. Regarding the FYFFP, S. Powers reminded of the adjustment made to allow unlimited credits appealed under FYFFP for COVID semesters. So far, no students have utilized or needed to utilize this amendment. Regarding the waiver of dismissal, S. Powers noted there is a disconnect between the codification and the email students receive about the waiver of dismissal. The latter includes the need for an

academic plan, the codification does not. A. Gatto asked for clarification of the WU versus the F grade. Discussion ensued.

- 6. New Business: A. Ott reported the Health Sciences degree was approved by the state.
- 7. **Adjournment**: After a motion from P. Jaijairam, the meeting adjourned at 3:09pm.

Meetings are held on the  $2^{nd}$  and  $4^{th}$  Wednesday of the month. The remaining spring meeting dates are: 2/22, 3/8, 3/22, 4/26, and 5/10. Unless changed, meetings will take place in Loew Hall, 200.

In summary, we have lots of policies for failed, repeated, failed INC, absence, withdrawal, etc. and these sometimes are not clear in terms of the appeal process(es). We have four appeals:

- Administrative (WU prior to fall 2021)
- F Replacement Policy (CUNY processed, limit of 16)
- FYFFP, limit of 12, effective fall 2019
- Waiver of Dismissal (code 5 or 7), and credit limit (code 3 or 6)

With the variety of changes over the years, and the implications for transfer and financial aid, we should review these over the course of the spring 2023 semester, and update, tweak, rewrite where appropriate. We can do this as a committee, or one sub-committee, or several sub-committees. We will review policies and decide on a procedure, or two. (8.1.7)
