<sup>1</sup>ENG 1/ENG 2 & RDL 1/RDL 2 are no longer offered. Students with ENG/RDL developmental need will now enroll in corequisite course ENG 100 (if English Proficiency Index is 0-49), **OR** ENG 110 (if English Proficiency Index is 50-64).

<sup>2</sup>Students must take FYS 11 prior to earning 24 degree or equated credits. Students who have earned 24 or more degree or equated credits are permitted to use the one credit as a free elective. It is recommended that students take FYS 11 in their first or second semester. This requirement will be waived for students who have earned 24 or more degree or equated credits at BCC or another college and transfer into this program.

<sup>3</sup>MTH 1/MTH 5 are no longer available. Students with Math Proficiency Index of 59 **OR** lower may now enroll in corequisite course MTH 21.5 **OR** MTH 23.5. Students with 39 **OR** lower MPI are strongly encouraged to enroll in Math Start/CUNY Start.

<sup>4</sup>Students may select either a 4-credit or 3-credit science course. Students selecting a 3 credit course must also complete an additional 1-credit Lab course to fulfill graduation requirements.

<sup>5</sup>**Students need one course in each flexible core area A-E.** The following courses are recommended to fulfill your Flexible Core:

Flexible Core A- A course from World Languages and Culture

Flexible Core B- HIS 20

Flexible Core C- ART 11 OR 12, or MUS 11 OR 12

Flexible Core D- COMM 11

Flexible Core E- Any 3 credit Scientific World course. Students taking a 4 credit course in this area will graduate with 61 credits.

Additional Flexible Core A-E- A second course from World Languages and Culture (same language)
