**Footnotes:**

<sup>1</sup>Students with English Proficiency Index (EPI) of 0-49 enroll in corequisite course ENG 100. Students with EPI of 50-64 enroll in corequisite course ENG 110. Students with EPI of at least 65 (or other English proficiency qualification) enroll in ENG 111. Students with ESL need should take appropriate ESL course(s) (Sequence: ESL 01->02->03->09) before enrolling in ENG 110.

<sup>2</sup>English majors are advised to take ENG 113, English Composition II: Writing about Literature, as their second composition course. However, the following courses are accepted as fulfilling this requirement as well: ENG 112, ENG 114, ENG 115, or ENG 116.

<sup>3</sup>Students with Math Proficiency Index (MPI) of 59 OR lower enroll in corequisite course MTH 21.5 OR MTH 23.5. Students with Math Proficiency Index of 39 OR lower are strongly encouraged to enroll in Math Start/CUNY Start.

<sup>4</sup>Students planning to transfer to John Jay College are advised to take one of their ENG electives in the flexible core.

<sup>8</sup>The World Languages and Cultures Department will consider exemption requests for students who present appropriate evidence that they have completed full-time study at a college or university outside of the United States in which the language of instruction was other than English. These students will be exempted from a foreign language requirement at Bronx Community College.

<sup>9</sup>This requirement is satisfied if a student takes a 4-credit STEM variant course in Required Area C.

<sup>10</sup>Students planning to transfer to John Jay College should choose from among these ENG electives: ENG 121, 133, 147, 148, 150, 151, 153, 156, 157, 161, 154.
