¹Students with English Proficiency Index (EPI) of 0-49 enroll in corequisite course ENG 100. Students with EPI of 50-64 enroll in corequisite course ENG 110. Students with EPI of at least 65 (or other English proficiency qualification) enroll in ENG 111. Students with ESL need should take appropriate ESL course(s) (Sequence: ESL 01->02->03->09) before enrolling in ENG 110.

²MTH 1/MTH 5 are no longer available. Students with Math Proficiency Index of 59 **OR** lower may now enroll in corequisite course MTH 21.5 **OR** MTH 23.5. Students with 39 **OR** lower MPI are strongly encouraged to enroll in Math Start/CUNY Start.

³Students may select either a 4-credit STEM variant science course or a 3-credit science course to fulfill Required Core C. Students selecting a 3-credit course must also complete an additional 1-credit lab course to fulfill graduation requirements.
