### Footnotes:

<sup>1</sup>Students with English Proficiency Index (EPI) of 0-49 enroll in corequisite course ENG 100. Students with EPI of 50-64 enroll in corequisite course ENG 110. Students with EPI of at least 65 (or other English proficiency qualification) enroll in ENG 111. Students with ESL need should take appropriate ESL course(s) (Sequence: ESL 01->02->03->09) before enrolling in ENG 110.

<sup>2</sup>Students with Math Proficiency Index (MPI) of 59 OR lower enroll in corequisite course MTH 21.5 OR MTH 23.5. Students with Math Proficiency Index of 39 OR lower are strongly encouraged to enroll in Math Start/CUNY Start.

<sup>3</sup> For students who have also enrolled in ENG 110 as a corequisite course.

<sup>6</sup>Enrollment in HSC 91 and HSC 92 require departmental approval and cannot be taken together, as HSC 91 is the prerequisite course for HSC 92. Students planning to enroll in HSC 91 are advised to meet with the Fieldwork Coordinator, ideally in the semester prior to their intention to enroll in the course. To be eligible to enroll in the HSC 91 and HSC 92 fieldwork courses, the following prerequisite courses must be completed first: HSC 10, HSC 12, PSY 11, and SOC 11. ENG 110/111, HSC 11, and SOC 35 are co-requisites (must be taken either before or with) HSC 91.

In order to apply for [graduation](#), students must complete all required courses with appropriate grades, complete two writing intensive courses, and have a minimum GPA of 2.0.
