B. REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM

Students must go to the CUNY portal and complete a transfer application. Application Priority Deadlines are as follows:

Spring Admissions: September 15

Fall Admissions: February 1

- Bronx Community College (BCC) graduates are exempt from all lower-division Lehman College General Education Degree Requirements.
- To earn the Bachelor's Degree at Lehman, CUNY BCC graduates need to complete the courses required for the major / minor, two upper-division interdisciplinary courses, one writing intensive course, and elective courses if needed.
- BCC students will be required to attain a minimum GPA of 2.5

Transfer Credit Summary and Additional Credits to Complete

Bronx Community College graduates with the Associate Degree in Health Sciences/Health Administration Option will receive 60 credits toward the Bachelor of Science in Health Services Administration at Lehman College. In addition, they will be deemed to have met all lower level, Pathways general education requirements at Lehman College.
