B. REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM

(e.g., minimum GPA, audition/portfolio):

Helene Fuld College of Nursing (HFCN) has a first come, first serve rolling admissions process.

The admission application is an online process using Nursing Centralized Application Service (NursingCAS) via <https://nursingcas.liaisoncas.org/apply/>.

Submitting a NursingCAS application early before the beginning of the start term is strongly encouraged.

Admission Requirements:

- United States citizen or eligible non-citizen
- Official transcript(s) from all colleges or universities attended, sent directly to NursingCAS.
- A minimum GPA cumulative average of 2.5. Note that program admission is highly competitive, with GPAs of 3.2 or higher recommended.
- Satisfactory performance on four computer-administered tests in reading comprehension, mathematics, Science, and English (TEAS Exam).
- CPR certification (BLS).

Transfer Credit Summary

Bronx Community College graduates with the Associate in Science Degree in Health Sciences will receive 61 credits toward the Bachelor of Science in Nursing at the Helene Fuld College of Nursing.
