### Health Administration Option

### A.S. Degree\*

<sup>1</sup> Students with English Proficiency Index (EPI) of 0-49 enroll in corequisite course ENG 100. Students with EPI of 50-64 enroll in corequisite course ENG 110. Students with EPI of at least 65 (or other English proficiency qualification) enroll in ENG 111. Students with ESL need should take appropriate ESL course/s (Sequence: ESL 01 > 02 > 03 > 09) before enrolling in ENG 110.

<sup>2</sup> Students with Math Proficiency Index (MPI) of 0-59 enroll in corequisite course MTH 23.5 OR MTH 28.5. Students with MPI of 39 or lower are strongly encouraged to enroll in Math Start/CUNY Start. Students in this curriculum with Nursing intent are strongly advised to take MTH 23 OR 23.5 to fulfill Required Core B. Students interested in Radiologic Technology, Nuclear Medicine Technology, and Medical Laboratory Technician should take MTH 28 OR 28.5.

<sup>3</sup> Students must complete five Flexible Core courses. One from each of the five Flexible Core areas A-E, and an additional course from any of the Flexible Core areas A-E. See [Common Core Pathways course listing](#). Note: This program has received a waiver to mandate specific STEM courses in Flexible Core E.

<sup>4</sup> Students in Health Administration Option should take BIO 21 The Human Body. Note: This program has received a waiver to mandate specific STEM courses in Required Core C. See [catalog](#) for more information.

<sup>5</sup> It is highly recommended that students take FYS 11 in their first or second semester prior to earning 24 credits. Students transferring into the program with 24 or more degree or equated credits will be exempt from FYS 11 and must take one credit of elective to satisfy this requirement.

**\*Note: In order to graduate, students must meet all requirements, including, completing all required courses with appropriate grades, completing two writing intensive courses, and earning a minimum GPA of 2.0, and [applying for graduation](#).**
