#### Black & Latinx Studies Option

### A.A. Degree\*

- <sup>1</sup> Students with English Proficiency Index (EPI) of 0-49 enroll in corequisite course ENG 100. Students with EPI of 50-64 enroll in corequisite course ENG 110. Students with EPI of at least 65 (or other English proficiency qualification) enroll in ENG 111. Students with ESL need should take appropriate ESL course/s (Sequence: ESL 01 > 02 > 03 > 09) before enrolling in ENG 110.
- <sup>2</sup> Students with Math Proficiency Index (MPI) of 0-59 enroll in corequisite course MTH 21.5 OR MTH 23.5. Students with MPI of 39 or lower are strongly encouraged to enroll in Math Start/CUNY Start.

## <sup>3</sup> Students need one course in each Flexible Core area A-E. The following courses are recommended:

- Flexible Core A two courses from same language: FRN, POR, SPN, or ARB
- Flexible Core B HIS 37
- Flexible Core C ART 12 or MUS 12
- Flexible Core D COMM 11
- Flexible Core E any 3-credit Scientific World course.

- <sup>4</sup> Select from any World Language listed at appropriate level except for ITL 123. The World Language Department will consider exemption requests for students who present appropriate evidence that they have completed full-time study at a college or university outside of the United States in which the language of instruction was other than English. These students will be exempted from a foreign language requirement at Bronx Community.
- <sup>5</sup> PEA 46 or PEA 47 highly recommended.
- 6 It is highly recommended that students take FYS 11 in their first or second semester prior to earning 24 credits. Students who have earned 24 or more credits are permitted to use the one credit as a free elective.
- <sup>7</sup> Students should select a 4-credit lab science to fulfill Required Core C. Select a 3-credit non-lab science course in Flexible Core E to fulfill graduation requirements.
- 8 Select free electives in consultation with the Black/Latinx Studies Coordinator.
- \*Note: In order to <u>apply for graduation</u>, students must complete all required courses with appropriate grades, complete two writing intensive courses, and have a minimum GPA of 2.0.
