²ENG 1/ENG 2 & RDL 1/RDL 2 are no longer available. Students with ENG/RDL remedial needs will now enroll in corequisite course ENG 100 (If English Proficiency Index 0-49), OR ENG 110 (If English Proficiency Index is 50-64).

³MTH 1/MTH 5 are no longer available. Students with Math Proficiency Index of 59 OR lower may now enroll in corequisite course MTH 21.5 OR MTH 23.5. Students with 39 OR lower MPI are strongly encouraged to enroll in Math Start/CUNY Start.

⁴Students may select either a 3-credit science course plus a lab course (1 cr.) or 4-credit STEM variant science course to fulfill Required Core C. Students selecting a 3-credit course in this area will have to take a 4-credit STEM variant science course in Flexible Area E in order to fulfill the lab requirement.
