A.S. Degree*

¹ Students with English Proficiency Index (EPI) of 0-49 enroll in corequisite course ENG 100. Students with EPI of 50-64 enroll in corequisite course ENG 110. Students with EPI of at least 65 (or other English proficiency qualification) enroll in ENG 111. Students with ESL need should take appropriate ESL course/s (Sequence: ESL 01 > 02 > 03 > 09) before enrolling in ENG 110.

² Students must complete five Flexible Core courses, one from each of the five Flexible Core areas A-E, and one additional course from any of the Flexible Core areas A-E.

The following courses are recommended:

Flexible Core A – HIS 10 **OR** HIS 11

Flexible Core B – POL 11

Flexible Core C – ART 11 OR ART 12/MUS 11 OR MUS 12

Flexible Core D – COMM 11

Flexible Core E – Any 3-credits course

Additional Flexible Core A-E – SOC 11

³ It is highly recommended that students take FYS 11 in their first or second semester prior to earning 24 credits. This requirement will be waived for students who have earned 24 or more degree or equated credits at BCC. Students transferring into the program with 24 or more degree or equated credits will also be exempt from FYS 11 and only required to complete 60 credits to graduate.

⁴ Students with Math Proficiency Index (MPI) of 0-59 enroll in corequisite course MTH 21.5 OR MTH 23.5. Students with MPI of 39 or lower are strongly encouraged to enroll in Math Start/CUNY Start. Students in this curriculum are strongly advised to take MTH 23 to fulfill required Core B.

⁵ Students with work experience in human services may receive life experience credit for this course. Please contact the Human Services program coordinator.

⁶ Students may receive credit for these courses based on a completed Family Development Certificate (FDC). The FDC may be completed either before starting the AS Human Services program or while enrolled. Please contact the Human Services program coordinator.

⁷ SOC 37, PSY 31, PSY 41, OR any Flexible Core course above are recommended to satisfy free elective credits.
