All of the positions listed below have a two-year term.

The Senate:

There are two (2) Senate seats reserved for holders of titles in the College Laboratory Technician Series. One (1) Senate Alternate may also be elected. A CLT elected as a Senator is also elected to the Faculty Council and may run for membership on the Senate Executive Committee.

CLTS, like all Instructional Staff at-large, are eligible to run for the following Standing Committees of the Senate: Governance and Elections

Student Activities

Space, Facilities, and Physical Plant

Community Events

Vice Presidents and Deans

Higher Education Officer Series Titles

This document lists all of the governance positions that HEOs are eligible to run for.

Please note that if a HEO is also a faculty member in an Adjunct teaching title, they are also eligible for any position open to Adjunct Teaching Faculty (such as the two Senate Adjunct and the Senate Adjunct Alternate positions.)

All of the positions listed below have a two-year term.

The Senate:

There are three (3) Senate seats reserved for holders of titles in the Higher Education Officer Series. One (1) Senate Alternate may also be elected.

There is one seat reserved specifically by and from the holders of titles in the Registrar's series and Higher Education Officers' series in the Registrar's Department.

A HEO elected as a Senator is also elected to the Faculty Council and may run for membership on the Senate Executive Committee.

HEOs, like all Instructional Staff at-large, are eligible to run for the following Standing Committees of the Senate: Governance and Elections
